AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the Office of the Attorney
General; requiring budgeting in certain categories
and amounts; requiring certain performance measures;
providing for duties and compensation of employees;
providing budgetary limitations; and providing an
effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2013, the
Attorney General shall budget all funds in the following categories
and amounts:

4 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for
5 each budget category.

6 SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not
7 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
8 upon the Office of the Attorney General by law shall be set by the
9 Attorney General. The Office of the Attorney General for the fiscal
10 year ending June 30, 2013, shall be subject to the following
11 budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees, except as
12 may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of
13 Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
