5 AS INTRODUCED

6 An Act relating to the regulation of prepared foods  
7 sold at farmers' markets; directing the State  
8 Department of Health to conduct certain study;  
9 providing specifications for such study; requiring  
certain report by specified date; providing for  
noncodification; and providing an effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be  
13 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

14 The State Department of Health shall study ways to modify the  
15 regulation of foods prepared for sale at farmers' markets. Such  
16 study shall take into consideration models that reduce unnecessary  
17 regulation while protecting the health of the public from the  
18 dangers of foodborne illness. The Department shall provide a  
19 written report of its findings to the President Pro Tempore of the  
20 Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives on or before  
21 December 31, 2011.

22 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2011.
