6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to oversize vehicles; amending 47
8 O.S. 2001, Section 14-103C, as last amended by
9 Section 10, Chapter 390, O.S.L. 2004 (47 O.S. Supp.
10 2010, Section 14-103C), which relates to movement of
houses or buildings; requiring consultation with
Department of Transportation for certain permits; and
declaring an emergency.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2001, Section 14-103C, as
15 last amended by Section 10, Chapter 390, O.S.L. 2004 (47 O.S. Supp.
16 2010, Section 14-103C), is amended to read as follows:

17 Section 14-103C. A. The Commissioner of Public Safety shall
18 upon proper application issue a special permit to any person
19 allowing the movement on state and federal highways of a structure
20 in the form of a house or building, including but not limited to
21 industrialized housing as defined in Section 14-103A of this title,
22 not exceeding thirty-two (32) feet in width at the base, and thirty-
23 four (34) feet in width at the top and twenty-one (21) feet in
24 height. The permit shall specify the highways to be used,

1 consistent with public convenience and safety, as determined by the
2 Commissioner of Public Safety, in consultation with the Department
3 of Transportation. In addition to the prohibitions on movement as
4 prescribed in Section 14-101 et seq. of this title, such structures
5 shall not be moved on Saturday or Sunday.

6 B. If any structure or housing described in subsection A of
7 this section has a width in excess of sixteen (16) feet, the towing
8 vehicle shall be a tandem-axle vehicle of no less than two hundred
9 twenty (220) horsepower.

10 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
11 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
12 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
13 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
