7 An Act relating to pharmacy copayments for
8 prescription drugs; limiting certain copayments;
9 directing the Board of Pharmacy to make certain
10 determination; providing for certain fine; providing
11 for codification; and providing an effective date.

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13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 374 of Title 59, unless there is
16 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 A. Pharmacies shall not charge a copayment for prescription
18 drugs that is greater than the cash value of the prescription drug.

19 B. The Board of Pharmacy shall determine the cash value of
20 prescription drugs on an annual basis based on the median retail
21 price of the prescription drug in the state.

22 C. Pharmacies that violate the provisions of subsection A of
23 this section may be fined by the Board in an amount not to exceed
24 Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for each violation.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2011.

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
