6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Wildlife Conservation  
8 Code; amending 29 O.S. 2001, Section 5-102, which  
9 relates to tagging wildlife; updating reference;  
specifying fee for certain tag; and providing an  
effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 29 O.S. 2001, Section 5-102, is  
14 amended to read as follows:

15 Section 5-102. A. No person may remove any propagated or  
16 released wildlife or domesticated animals hunted for sport which are  
17 killed at a commercial hunting area, without attaching a tag to each  
18 of such killed wildlife or domesticated animals hunted for sport.

19 B. The tags, supplied by the ~~Commission~~ Department of Wildlife  
20 Conservation at reasonable cost, shall contain such information as  
21 the Commission may require and shall be numbered consecutively. The  
22 tags for the animals donated to the Hunters Against Hunger program  
23 shall be Five Dollars (\$5.00).

1 C. Such tag must remain attached to the individual wildlife or  
2 domesticated animals hunted for sport until prepared and consumed  
3 and shall not be used more than once.

4 D. Any person convicted of violating the provisions of this  
5 section shall be punished by a fine of not less than One Hundred  
6 Dollars (\$100.00) nor more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), or  
7 by imprisonment in the county jail not to exceed sixty (60) days, or  
8 by both such fine and imprisonment.

9 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2011.
