6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to outdoor advertising; amending 69
8 O.S. 2001, Section 1281, which relates to outdoor
9 advertising; removing Department of Transportation
10 authority to use certain monies for matching federal
11 funds or other purposes; amending 69 O.S. 2001,
12 Section 1282, which relates to violations; providing
13 penalties for violations; and declaring an emergency.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 69 O.S. 2001, Section 1281, is
16 amended to read as follows:

17 Section 1281. The Department of Transportation is authorized to
18 use any funds appropriated to it ~~or received by it from the state~~
19 ~~road fund~~ for matching federal funds or for other lawful purposes of
20 this act.

21 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 69 O.S. 2001, Section 1282, is
22 amended to read as follows:

23 Section 1282. Any person, firm or corporation violating the
24 provisions of ~~this act~~ Section 1271 et seq. of this title shall,
upon conviction, be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and subject to a

1 fine of up to One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00), and each day of
2 violation shall be considered a separate offense.

3 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
4 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
5 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
6 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
