6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to wildlife; prohibiting use of  
8 certain hunting aids; defining term; providing  
9 exception; specifying penalty; providing for  
10 codification; and providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5-203.2 of Title 29, unless  
15 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 A. Except for battery powered scoping devices that project a  
17 light or dot inside the scope and pin sight lights on archery  
18 equipment, no person shall use a laser sighting device as a hunting  
19 aid. As used in this section "laser sighting device" means any  
20 artificial light or any form that casts or reflects a beam of light  
21 onto or otherwise illuminates wildlife.

22 B. The provisions of subsection A of this section shall not  
23 apply to persons who are one hundred percent (100%) disabled as  
24 certified by a physician licensed in this state or any state which

1 borders this state, if the person is hunting on private property and  
2 is accompanied by a licensed hunter as provided in Section 4-112 of  
3 Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

4 C. Any person convicted of violating the provisions of this  
5 section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

6 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2011.
