7 An Act relating to the State Fire Marshal; amending
8 74 O.S. 2001, Sections 320 and 324.20b, as last
9 amended by Section 4, Chapter 269, O.S.L. 2005 (74
10 O.S. Supp. 2010, Section 324.20b), which relate to
11 prohibitions on the State Fire Marshal and the State
Fire Marshal Revolving Fund; prohibiting engaging in
business that is a conflict of interest; removing
monetary limit on the State Fire Marshal Revolving
Fund; and providing an effective date.

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14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2001, Section 320, is
16 amended to read as follows:

17 Section 320. The State Fire Marshal shall not engage in any
18 other business ~~and he and his assistant~~ that may be a conflict of
19 interest with duties of the State Fire Marshal. The State Fire
20 Marshal and the Assistant State Fire Marshal shall at all times be
21 ready for such duties as are required by ~~this act~~ Sections 314
22 through 326.11 of this title.

1 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2001, Section 324.20b, as
2 last amended by Section 4, Chapter 269, O.S.L. 2005 (74 O.S. Supp.
3 2010, Section 324.20b), is amended to read as follows:

4 Section 324.20b There is hereby created in the State Treasury a
5 revolving fund for the State Fire Marshal to be designated the
6 "State Fire Marshal Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a continuing
7 fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of
8 monies received from the sale of surplus property, fees and receipts
9 collected pursuant to the Oklahoma Open Records Act, fines,
10 forfeitures, fees, charges, receipts, donations, gifts, bequests,
11 contributions, devises, interagency reimbursements, federal funds
12 unless otherwise provided by federal law or regulation, or any other
13 source. ~~The fund shall consist of no more than Five Hundred Fifty~~
14 ~~Thousand Dollars (\$550,000.00).~~ All monies accruing to the credit
15 of the fund are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and expended
16 by the State Fire Marshal for authorized purposes. Expenditures
17 from the fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State
18 Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with the
19 Director of State Finance for approval and payment.

20 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2011.
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
