6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to school administration; creating  
8 the Administrative Reform Act; providing short title;  
9 permitting school districts to contract for office  
10 space with local government; requiring the sale of  
11 office space no longer used; providing for  
12 codification; providing for noncodification;  
13 providing an effective date; and declaring an  
14 emergency.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be  
17 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

18 This act shall be know and may be cited as the "Administrative  
19 Reform Act".

20 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
21 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5-106B of Title 70, unless there  
22 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

23 A. School districts shall be permitted to contract with a  
24 county or municipality to lease property for administrative services  
and offices.

1 B. School district property which is no longer used for  
2 administrative purposes, due to the leasing of property from a  
3 county or a municipality, and for which there is no outstanding  
4 indebtedness, shall be sold and all monies applied to the Teacher's  
5 Retirement System of Oklahoma, as defined in Section 17-102 of Title  
6 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

7 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2011.

8 SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
9 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
10 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
11 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
