6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to accident and health insurance
8 policies; prohibiting certain insurance policies to
9 be subject to certain differential because of gender;
providing for codification; and providing an
effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 4405.2 of Title 36, unless there
15 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 An individual accident and health insurance policy issued,
17 amended, or renewed on or after January 1, 2012, shall not be
18 subject to premium, price, or charge differentials because of the
19 gender of any contracting party, potential contracting party, or
20 person reasonably expected to benefit from the policy as a
21 policyholder, insured, or otherwise.

22 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2011.
