6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to the Joint Task Force on the Grand
8 River Dam Authority; amending Section 3, Chapter 192,
9 O.S.L. 2007 (82 O.S. Supp. 2010, Section 863.3),
10 which relates to the task force; requiring certain
11 biennial meetings; authorizing additional meetings;
12 requiring certain annual report to the task force;
13 and declaring an emergency.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 3, Chapter 192, O.S.L.
16 2007 (82 O.S. Supp. 2010, Section 863.3), is amended to read as
17 follows:

18 Section 863.3 A. There is hereby created the Joint Legislative
19 Task Force on the Grand River Dam Authority for the purpose of
20 studying the functions, activities, policies, procedures and
21 expenditures performed by the district and any related issues the
22 task force deems appropriate. Members of the task force shall be
23 appointed in January of each year following a state general election
24 by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of the
House of Representatives. Membership shall be made up of all Senate

1 and House members whose legislative districts include a portion of
2 the Grand River Dam Authority district. The President Pro Tempore
3 and Speaker shall each designate one of their members to be cochairs
4 of the task force. The task force shall be required to meet at
5 least once biennially during the first session of each new
6 legislature. Additional meetings may be called as the cochairs
7 determine necessary. Meetings of the task force shall be called by
8 the cochairs. A majority of the appointed members shall constitute
9 a quorum for any meeting of the task force. Staffing assistance
10 shall be provided by the staff of the Senate and House of
11 Representatives.

12 B. The members of the task force created herein shall continue
13 to serve until new members are appointed pursuant to the provisions
14 of subsection A of this section. Such task force is authorized to
15 adopt any recommendations or issue any report it deems necessary.
16 Any recommendations or reports shall be approved by a majority of
17 the appointed members. Copies of any recommendations or reports
18 issued by the task force shall be distributed to the Governor, the
19 President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of
20 Representatives, the members of the Grand River Dam Authority Board
21 of Directors and the General Manager of the Grand River Dam
22 Authority.

23 C. The Grand River Dam Authority shall annually provide a copy
24 of the district's most recent annual report to the members of the

1 task force in addition to any information requested pursuant to the
2 provisions of this section.

3 D. Members serving on this task force shall be entitled to
4 travel reimbursement as provided by Section 456 of Title 74 of the
5 Oklahoma Statutes.

6 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
7 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
8 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
9 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
