6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to consent to treatment of a minor;
8 permitting certain health care practitioners to treat
9 a child without consent in cases of suspected abuse
or neglect; providing for codification; and providing
an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-3-104 of Title 10A, unless
15 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 A physician, dentist, psychologist, registered nurse, surgeon,
17 intern, physician assistant, or any other health professional
18 authorized to examine a child, having reasonable grounds to believe
19 that the child's physical or mental condition has been adversely
20 affected by abuse or neglect, whether mental, physical, or sexual,
21 may examine the child without the consent of the child's parents or
22 other person authorized to consent to treatment.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2011.
