7 An Act relating to therapist and counselor
8 representation; requiring certain persons to make
9 specified disclosure; providing for codification; and
10 providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1949.2 of Title 59, unless there
15 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 Any person who represents himself or herself by the title
17 "therapist" or "counselor" shall disclose whether or not he or she
18 is licensed to practice in this state and, if not, any credentials
19 or specialized training he or she has received. Such
20 representations shall include, but are not limited to, business
21 cards, websites, and advertisements.

22 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2011.
