5 AS INTRODUCED

6 An Act relating to health insurance coverage;  
7 requiring certain health benefit plans to provide  
8 coverage for prescription eye drops for certain  
9 dependents; requiring the coverage to be subject to  
certain limits; defining term; providing for  
codification; and providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6060.6a of Title 36, unless  
15 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 A. Any health benefit plan that is delivered, issued for  
17 delivery or renewed in this state on or after January 1, 2012, that  
18 provides coverage for prescription eye drops for the dependents of  
19 an insured individual shall provide coverage for each child of the  
20 insured, from birth through the date the child is eighteen (18)  
21 years of age for one additional bottle of prescription eye drops  
22 when:

1        1. The bottle is requested by the insured or the prescribing  
2 physician or optometrist at the time the original prescription is  
3 filled, and

4        2. The prescribing physician or optometrist indicates on the  
5 original prescription that the additional bottle is needed by the  
6 insured for use in a day care center or school.

7        B. The coverage provided for by this section shall be subject  
8 to the same annual deductibles, co-payments or coinsurance limits as  
9 established for other covered benefits under the health plan.

10       C. As used in this section, "health benefit plan" means any  
11 plan or arrangement as defined in subsection C of Section 6060.4 of  
12 Title 36 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

13       SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2011.
