5 AS INTRODUCED

6 An Act relating to the State Board of Licensure for
7 Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors; amending
8 59 O.S. 2001, Section 475.10, as last amended by
9 Section 3, Chapter 312, O.S.L. 2008 (59 O.S. Supp.
10 2010, Section 475.10), modifying language.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2001, Section 475.10, as
13 last amended by Section 3, Chapter 312, O.S.L. 2008 (59 O.S. Supp.
14 2010, Section 475.10), is amended to read as follows:

15 Section 475.10. A. The State Board of Licensure for
16 Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors shall keep a record of its
17 proceedings and of all applications for licensure, which record
18 shall show:

- 19 1. The name, date of birth and last-known address of each
20 applicant;
- 21 2. The date of application;
- 22 3. The place of business of the applicant;
- 23 4. The education, experience and other qualifications of the
24 applicant;

- 1 5. The type of examination required;
- 2 6. Whether or not the applicant was rejected;
- 3 7. Whether or not a certificate of licensure was granted;
- 4 8. The date of the action of the Board; and
- 5 9. Such other information as may be deemed necessary by the
- 6 Board.

7 B. The record of the Board shall be prima facie evidence of the
8 proceedings of the Board and a transcript thereof, duly certified by
9 the Secretary under seal, shall be admissible as evidence with the
10 same force and effect as if the original were produced.

11 C. The Board shall submit, upon request from the Governor, a
12 report of its transactions of the preceding year, including a
13 complete statement of the receipts and expenditures of the Board,
14 attested by affidavits of its ~~Chairman~~ Chair and its Secretary.

15 D. Board records and papers of the following class may be kept
16 confidential by the Board: examination materials, file records of
17 examination problem solutions, exam scores, letters of inquiry and
18 reference concerning applicants, transcripts of college courses and
19 grades, investigation files, closed complaints, information
20 otherwise protected by law and all other matters of like
21 confidential nature.
