6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to illegal immigration; establishing
8 procedures for deportation of certain persons;
9 requiring certain information be forwarded under
10 certain circumstances; requiring certain state
11 agencies to develop certain procedures; requiring
12 certain information be forwarded to certain federal
13 authorities; providing for codification; and
14 providing an effective date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 530.5 of Title 57, unless there
18 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 A. Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, any prisoner in the
20 custody of the Department of Corrections that is subject to an order
21 of deportation from the United States Citizenship and Immigration
22 Services pursuant to Section 530.4 of Title 57 of the Oklahoma
23 Statutes shall also have any person related within the third degree
24 by affinity or consanguinity to the prisoner and who is receiving
any state assistance as provided in Section 71 of Title 56 of the
Oklahoma Statutes and are determined to maintain an illegal presence

1 subject to deportation and done so without prejudice to nationality,
2 color, race, religion, or gender.

3 B. Any persons meeting the criteria and related to the prisoner
4 pursuant to subsection A of this section that are discovered or
5 disclosed to the Department shall be forwarded to law enforcement to
6 coordinate with proper federal authorities for determination of
7 citizenship status. The Director shall also forward the name of the
8 prisoner or otherwise make available all names of prisoners that are
9 subject to an order of deportation to all state agencies that
10 provide state assistance. Upon receipt of the prisoner's name by a
11 state agency providing state assistance, the director or executive
12 officer of such agency shall develop procedures for determining if
13 there is a relation to the prisoner as provided in this section that
14 is receiving state assistance. Any such relation discovered by the
15 agency meeting the criteria of this section shall be forwarded to
16 law enforcement to coordinate with proper federal authorities in
17 order to determine citizenship status.

18 C. Information collected and determined to meet the
19 requirements of this section shall be forwarded to the United States
20 Citizenship and Immigration Services so an order for deportation may
21 be processed on those relations subject to this section.

22 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2011.

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
