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6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to state golf courses; stating
8 Legislative intent to create task force to study
9 requiring state owned and operated golf courses to be
10 under private administration by certain date;
11 requiring report by certain date; stating
12 distribution; stating requirements for report;
13 providing for noncodification; and declaring an
14 emergency.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
17 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

18 It is the intent of the Oklahoma Legislature to create a task
19 force, to be charged with the duty of determining the feasibility of
20 requiring all state owned and operated golf courses to be sold,
21 leased or otherwise transferred to appropriate private ownership
22 within five (5) years from the effective date of this act. The task
23 force shall make a report to the Governor, the President Pro Tempore
24 of the Senate and the Speaker of the House. The report shall
include a plan outlining the number and location of all such

1 publicly owned and operated facilities and specific measures
2 necessary to transfer the facilities to private ownership, including
3 any legislative recommendations necessary to fulfill the
4 requirements of this act. The report shall be completed no later
5 than November 1, 2011.

6 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
7 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
8 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
9 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
