6 AS INTRODUCED

7 A Resolution expressing the desire that the Oklahoma  
8 Department of Human Services adopt a plan to continue  
9 the operation of a state-administered resource center  
10 or resource centers; and directing distribution.

11 WHEREAS, the Oklahoma Legislature has passed House Concurrent  
12 Resolution 1030, which disapproved the plan previously submitted by  
13 the Oklahoma Department of Human Services pursuant to Section 3051  
14 of Title 56 of the Oklahoma Statutes; and

15 WHEREAS, the Oklahoma State Senate wishes to express to the  
16 Department of Human Services its commitment to continue to provide  
17 for a state-administered facility, or facilities, to address the  
18 needs of the most fragile, vulnerable and severely handicapped  
19 citizens of the state; and

20 WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the State of Oklahoma,  
21 these citizens and their families, that the state maintain a state-  
22 administered facility, or facilities, that provides these citizens  
23 with access to qualified health care, dental care, vision care,  
24 rehabilitation services and vocational services.

1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION  
2 OF THE 53RD OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

3 THAT the Oklahoma State Senate expresses its desire that the  
4 Department of Human Services adopt a plan to continue the operation  
5 of a state-administered resource center or centers for approval by  
6 the Legislature in the 2013 session.

7 THAT the plan shall include input from the parents, guardians,  
8 employees, community members and legislators.

9 THAT a copy of this resolution be distributed to the Director of  
10 the Department of Human Services and to the members of the Human  
11 Services Commission.

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
