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9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the Department of Public Safety;
11 creating the Department of Public Safety Restricted
12 Revolving Fund; specifying type of fund;
13 appropriating monies credited to the fund for
14 specific purposes; requiring transfer of certain
15 funds; creating the Department of Public Safety
16 Patrol Academy Revolving Fund; specifying type of
17 fund; appropriating monies credited to the fund for
18 specific purposes; providing for the expenditure of
19 funds; providing for codification; providing
20 effective date; and declaring an emergency.

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23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

24 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2-145 of Title 47, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving
fund for the Department of Public Safety, to be designated the
"Department of Public Safety Restricted Revolving Fund". The fund

1 shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations.
2 All monies accruing to the credit of said fund are hereby
3 appropriated and shall be budgeted and expended by the Department of
4 Public Safety for the restricted purposes of the monies as
5 prescribed by law. Expenditures from said funds shall be made upon
6 warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as
7 prescribed by law with the Director of State Finance for approval
8 and payment.

9 B. Any statutory references to the Department of Public Safety
10 Revolving Fund shall mean the Department of Public Safety Restricted
11 Revolving Fund, as provided for in this section, whenever the
12 expenditure of the monies is restricted by law.

13 C. The Department of Public Safety shall transfer all funds,
14 for which expenditure is restricted by law, from the Department of
15 Public Safety Revolving Fund to the Department of Public Safety
16 Restricted Revolving Fund.

17 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2-146 of Title 47, unless there
19 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

20 There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund
21 for the Department of Public Safety, to be designated the
22 "Department of Public Safety Patrol Academy Revolving Fund". The
23 fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year
24 limitations. All monies accruing to the credit of said fund are

1 hereby appropriated and shall be budgeted and expended by the
2 Department of Public Safety for the exclusive purpose of Oklahoma
3 Highway Patrol Trooper Academies. Expenditures from said fund shall
4 be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims
5 filed as prescribed by law with the Director of State Finance for
6 approval and payment.

7 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2011.

8 SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
9 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
10 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
11 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
