10 COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

11 An Act relating to the Department of Corrections;  
12 requiring certain funds be used for certain purposes;  
13 requiring certain spending level; authorizing  
14 expenditure of certain funds; providing an effective  
15 date; and declaring an emergency.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. From the funds appropriated to the Department of  
18 Corrections in Sections 144 and 145 of Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1975  
19 of the 2nd Session of the 53rd Oklahoma Legislature, Two Million  
20 Nine Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$2,900,000.00) shall be used for  
21 security enhancements, population reduction and renovation at the  
22 Oklahoma State Penitentiary.

23 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2013, the  
24 Department of Corrections shall spend an amount equal to what it

1 spent on private prisons and halfway houses for the fiscal year  
2 ending June 30, 2012, plus an additional Two Million Dollars  
3 (\$2,000,000.00).

4 SECTION 3. The Department of Corrections is hereby authorized  
5 to expend from the Industries Revolving Fund created pursuant to  
6 Section 541 of Title 57 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the sum of One  
7 Million Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$1,250,000.00) or so  
8 much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon  
9 the Department of Corrections by law.

10 SECTION 4. This act shall become effective July 1, 2012.

11 SECTION 5. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
12 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
13 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
14 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
