8 AS INTRODUCED

9 An Act relating to the State Department of  
10 Rehabilitation Services; authorizing certain early  
11 transfers of certain funds for specific purposes;  
12 authorizing transfer of appropriated money in  
13 requested amounts and ratios; authorizing certain  
14 interyear transfers; requiring certain process and  
15 maintenance of records; providing an effective date;  
16 and declaring an emergency.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. The Director of the State Department of  
19 Rehabilitation Services may request through the Director of the  
20 Office of State Finance the early transfer by the Oklahoma Tax  
21 Commission of tax collection to the General Revenue Fund for the  
22 purpose of early allocation to the Department's disbursing funds to  
23 alleviate cash-flow problems.

24 SECTION 2. The Director of the Department of Rehabilitation  
Services may request the Director of the Office of State Finance to  
transfer funds from the Rehabilitation Services Federal Fund to

1 Rehabilitation Services Disbursing Funds and to Department of  
2 Rehabilitation Services Medical and Assistance Funds for expenditure  
3 in the client service, supported employment, and independent living  
4 programs.

5 SECTION 3. The Director of the Office of State Finance shall  
6 transfer monies appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the  
7 State Department of Rehabilitation Services Disbursing Funds in the  
8 amounts and ratios requested by the agency except that the  
9 cumulative amounts transferred shall not exceed the cumulative  
10 amounts of equal monthly allotments of the appropriations from the  
11 General Revenue Fund.

12 Monies appropriated or collected from the fiscal year ending  
13 June 30, 2012, may be transferred to these disbursing funds for the  
14 fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, to satisfy encumbrances and  
15 obligations of said fiscal year; provided, that monies equal in  
16 amount are transferred from appropriations or collections for the  
17 fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, to the disbursing funds for the  
18 fiscal year ending June 30, 2012, to satisfy encumbrances and  
19 obligations of said fiscal year. All transfer requests shall be in  
20 writing to the Director of the Office of State Finance. The State  
21 Department of Rehabilitation Services shall maintain records of the  
22 interyear transfers.

23 SECTION 4. This act shall become effective July 1, 2011.

1       SECTION 5. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
2 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
3 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
4 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
