**Thirteenth Legislative Day, Monday, February 27, 2012**

Advising passage of and transmitting for consideration Engrossed **HBs 2281, 2318, 2547** and **2787**.

An Act relating to counties and county officers; amending 19 O.S. 2011, Section 180.65, which relates to deputies; authorizing certain officers to designate undersheriff; authorizing undersheriff to perform certain duties; and providing an effective date.

An Act relating to insurance; amending 36 O.S. 2011, Section 309.2, which relates to authority of the Insurance Commissioner to perform certain examinations; modifying

frequency of examinations; authorizing Commissioner to adopt certain rules; and providing an effective date.
