Research Analysis

The measure makes modifications to the Juvenile Sex Offender Registration Act to comply with the provisions of the federal Adam Walsh Act. Requires Office of Juvenile Affairs to send juvenile registration to the Department of Corrections for placement in the Oklahoma sex offender registry. Requires offenders currently on the juvenile sex offender registry to be placed on the adult registry when the offender reaches 18 years of age. Requires any offender 14 years of age who commits a sex offense after July 1, 2011 to be registered on the adult registry. Requires notification by the registrant to be made to tribal police. Provides process for petition for release from registry requirements after 25 years. Requires registered offenders to supply palm prints. Requires copy of information in the adult registration to be made available to the State Superintendent of Public Instruction and the State Commissioner of Health. Repeals 10 O.S. Section 7308-1.4 relating to requiring District Attorney to make application to place juvenile offender on registry.
