The measure establishes a \$13 fee on all civil cases filed in district court which is to be assessed and credited to the Oklahoma court-appointed special advocates (OCASA).

Fiscal Analysis

According to the Administrative Office of the Courts, there were 152,654 civil cases filed in FY-10. If the court collects \$13 for every case filed it will generate approximately \$2 million annually for Oklahoma Court-Appointed Special Advocates (OCASA), a non-profit designed to provide trained volunteers to serve as advocates for abused and neglected children. HB1414 has no impact on state revenues.
