**Research Analysis**

The measure increases the fine for willfully entering without permission a facility licensed pursuant to the Oklahoma Farmed Cervidae Act or a commercial hunting area licensed pursuant to Oklahoma law. The fine will be no more than \$1,500 rather than no more than \$250.

**Fiscal Analysis**

HB 1474, as introduced, increases the penalty for trespass on the grounds of a facility licensed under the Farmed Cervidae Act. The revenue from the fine increase would go to the county in which the offense occurred, but there is no impact to the Wildlife Department or the state.
