Research Analysis

The subcommittee recommendation for Senate Bill 1565 restores the title. The measure instructs the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education to select not more than two institutions within the Oklahoma State System of Higher Education to participate in a dyslexia teacher training pilot program. Institutions must provide institutes for teachers of grades kindergarten through fourth grade to train teachers on the indicators of dyslexia and the types of instruction children with dyslexia need. Institutions also must provide instruction for teacher candidates enrolled in elementary, early childhood education of special education programs. Instruction must train teacher candidates on the indicators of dyslexia and the type of instruction those students need. The pilot program will be established for three years and participating institutions must report results no later than June 30 of the third year.
