Research Analysis

The measure establishes a criminal act for any public employee who has authority to issue, revoke, suspend or deny a license, permit or certification to coerce, command, advise or direct a person who is seeking a license to pay, lend or contribute money, time effort or any thing else of value to any party, committee, organization, agency or person for political purposes. Punishment is a felony subject to a fine of not more than \$10,000, up to 2 years imprisonment or both fine and imprisonment. Provides that lying while under oath at a legislative proceeding is to be considered perjury. Provides that any public official or employee who knowingly provides false or misleading information to the Legislature, a member of the Legislature, a legislative committee or subcommittee or a legislative staff member is guilty of perjury.
