Research Analysis

FA7 adds a new section of law declaring Oklahoma to be a Second Amendment state and that all citizens have the right to keep and bear arms for his or her protections. Provides that persons or entities who prevent a citizen from exercising Second Amendment rights are assuming the liability for protecting the citizen. Allows any citizen of Oklahoma to request an endorsement on their Oklahoma driver license to serve as a concealed carry permit for recognition in this state and other states.

Removes Sections 1 through 48 of HB 1796.

Repeals the following statutes relating to the regulation and control of firearms:

Fiscal Analysis

FA7 to HB1796 will have a significant fiscal impact on the Oklahoma Bureau of Investigation's (OSBI) annual revenue. According to the OSBI, the annual revenue loss from the elimination of the concealed carry license process would be between \$2.75 million and \$3.5 million and would necessitate an additional \$1.5-\$2 million appropriation to the OSBI.
