**Research Analysis**

HB1840 as introduced provides for the portion of Interstate 35 in Oklahoma City from Northeast 23<sup>rd</sup> Street extending north to the junction of Interstate 35 and Interstate 44 to be designated as the “Honorable Hannah Diggs Atkins, Secretary of State, Memorial Highway” and provides for permanent markers to be placed upon the highway bearing that name.

**Fiscal Analysis**

The Oklahoma Department of Transportation has previously indicated that the cost of signs on roads and bridges ranges between \$200 - \$1,000 per sign depending on size and complexity. Most signage cost on designated roads and bridges are near the low end of the cost scale.
