Research Analysis

The Subcommittee Recommendation for HB 1905 establishes a new “Freestanding Multidisciplinary Team Account” in addition to the existing Child Abuse Multidisciplinary Account (CAMA) at the Department of Human Services and modifies the criteria used by DHS to distribute monies from the funds. The measure assesses \$4.00 to the monetary penalty for certain traffic violations that will be collected by the court clerk and credited evenly between the two funds.

Fiscal Analysis

Oklahoma Department of Human Services (OKDHS) contracts with the child advocacy centers and freestanding multidisciplinary teams for monitoring and distribution of funds deposited into the current CAMA account and will do the same for the FTMA according to bill language.

Based upon the FY-2011 appropriation, OKDHS collected \$14,000 as the administrative fee allowed for managing the accounts. Under this bill the fee would be reduced by half to \$7,000.
