The measure extends the school year to 183 days or to 1,098 hours from 180 days or 1,080 hours. Implementation of the measure will be contingent upon the Legislature appropriating state funds for the specific purpose of extending the school year.

Fiscal Analysis

As the measure's provisions are contingent on the availability of funding, there is no immediate impact. If funding were provided, the State Department of Education estimates the additional cost per school day at \$18,000,000 (based on information provided by the Time Reform Task Force), thus bringing the three-day total to \$54,000,000.
