Research Analysis

Floor Amendment 5 to HB 2135 deletes Sections 1-7 related to the Prevention of Youth Access to Tobacco Act and Legislative Intent and creates the five-member Joint Legislative Task Force on Smoking Regulation to study the effects of local smoking regulation in the state. The task force is composed of the Governor or designee, two members of the House appointed by the Speaker and two members of the Senate appointed by the Pro Tem.

Fiscal Analysis

Floor Amendment 5 creates the Joint Legislative Task Force on Smoking Regulation. The Task Force will include the Governor or designee, two Representatives and two Senators. The fiscal impact of the measure is limited to the required reimbursement of travel expenses by the appointing agencies of the Task Force membership. Such travel reimbursement is anticipated to be minimal and have \$0 direct impact on the appropriations of the agencies affected.
