**Research Analysis**

HB 2170, the General Appropriations Bill, appropriates \$6,510,387,282 to agencies of the executive, legislative and judicial departments of the state.

**Fiscal Analysis**

Total appropriations included in the measure represent a reduction of \$211.2 million, or 3.14 percent, when compared to the appropriations made for FY-11.

Individual agency funding reductions range from no reduction to nine percent (9.0%). The measure also transfers certain funds and funding requirements and provides certain clarifications as the use of funds.
