Research Analysis

HB 2183 directs \$178,000 of the funds appropriated to the Department of Human Services (DHS) in General Appropriations bill be used to provide hearing services to deaf or hard of hearing children statewide. The bill further contains intent language that DHS fully fund programs in Aging Services, the Developmental Disability Services Division, and related to foster and child adoption. The legislation also directs the payment of Child Abuse Multidisciplinary Account funds.

Fiscal Analysis

Section 1 of HB 2183 directs how \$178,000 of DHS' FY-12 appropriation will be used to provide hearing services to deaf or hard of hearing children statewide. Sections 2 through 6 outline legislative intent that DHS fully fund certain specified programs totaling approximately \$315 million based on an FY-11 DHS Budget Work Plan of \$2.4 billion.
