Fiscal Analysis

According to officials from the Health Care Authority (OHCA), the proposed rules addressed by HJR 1102 in combination with the proposed rules addressed by HJR 1103; would directly require \$601,125 in State Share from the Department of Human Services (OKDHS) to draw down approximately \$1,113,435 in federal matching funds to be used to implement the services. OHCA anticipates the overall Medicaid Program fiscal impact to be minimal if not neutral; because the created services would be replacing existing services.
