**Research Analysis**

HJR 1103 disapproves the following permanent rules relating to Developmental Disabilities Services adopted by the Oklahoma Health Care Authority Board on March 8, 2012: OAC 317:40-5-3, 317:40-5-5, 317:40-5-8, 317:40-5-9, 317:40-5-13, 317:40-5-59, 317:40-5-101, 317:40-5-113, 317:40-7-12, 317:40-7-15 and 317:40-7-21.

**Fiscal Analysis**

According to officials from the Health Care Authority (OHCA), the proposed rules addressed by HJR 1103 in combination with the proposed rules addressed by HJR 1102; would directly require \$601,125 in State Share from the Department of Human Services (OKDHS) to draw down approximately \$1,113,435 in federal matching funds to be used to implement the services. OHCA anticipates the overall Medicaid Program fiscal impact to be minimal if not neutral; because the created services would be replacing existing services.
