Fiscal Analysis

The amendment directs the Department of Transportation (ODOT) to place permanent markers upon the three highways and four bridges bearing the names of members of the armed forces. ODOT estimates the cost of markers to average \$650.00 each and, with the placement of markers for each direction of travel, the total estimated cost for placement is \$9,100.

The measure also designates two sections of highway and four bridges for persons not killed in action as members of the armed forces of the United States. Costs for markers for these designations are to be borne by sponsors of the designation, as provided by law.
