Engrossed SB1640 modifies the penalty for evasion of payment of tolls to \$25.00 for each violation. Currently the penalty is \$25.00 for the first violation, \$50.00 for the second violation if incurred within 18 months of the first violation, and \$75.00 for the third violation if incurred within 18 months of the first violation.

Fiscal Analysis

Officials with the Oklahoma Turnpike Authority have concluded that, although there is no measurable fiscal impact to the Authority a reduced and flat rate penalty structure would foster a more positive customer experience, especially during resolution discussions of outstanding violations. The provisions may also better facilitate Authority efforts to convert violators to electronic toll customers (PikePass), simplify database processing codes and manual calculations and several other benefits to the Authority.
