Floor amendment No. 2 to Senate Bill 1743 removes language that would have required a \$200 fee to reinstate hunting and fishing licenses revoked due to violations to the law regarding usage of suppression devices on firearms. The amendment also removes the \$500 reinstatement fee for nonresident licenses.

Fiscal Analysis

FA2 to SB 1743 would remove a provision allowing the Wildlife Department to charge a \$200 license reinstatement fee to residents and a \$500 license reinstatement fee to nonresidents who have be charged with illegally using a suppressor device on a firearm. The suspension of the license is automatic and Wildlife officials estimate a possible 20 residents and 10 nonresidents being charged annually.
