SB 299, as engrossed, modifies duties of the Board of Chiropractic Examiners related to investigations by authorizing the Board to contract with CLEET-certified investigators and providing for investigative procedures.

Fiscal Analysis

SB 299 allows the Board of Chiropractic Examiners to contract with CLEET certified investigators to perform investigative duties. The Board does not anticipate a material increase in operating costs as a result. The measure also authorizes the Board to issue administrative penalties for field citations, \$250 for first offense and \$1,000,000 for subsequent offenses. The Board estimates less than \$10,000 will be generated annually by such administrative penalties. The Board of Chiropractic Examiners is a non appropriated state agency; therefore, the measure has no impact on the state budget or appropriations.
