**Fiscal Analysis**

The CS for SB 335 amends the Oklahoma Floodplain Management Act. According to officials at the Water Resources Board, this would involve OWRB taking over permitting responsibilities for oil and gas activities in floodplain areas to provide a statewide one-stop-shop for permitting these activities. OWRB officials state that they are negotiating a fee schedule with all interested parties and thus expect there to be no fiscal impact to the state.
