Fiscal Analysis

According to Oklahoma Department of Human Services (OKDHS), to comply with the provisions of HB 1194l, OKDHS must develop a form or forms similar to the Oklahoma State Department of Health's medical and social history forms currently known as the ODH-347-1, ODH-347-2, and ODH-3 entitled "Medical and Social History of the Child, Birth Mother, and Birth Father", respectively.

The form or forms will be furnished in electronic format only. OKDHS believes that no fiscal impact is anticipated with regards to the bill.
