HB 1538, as introduced, adds pneumococcal disease to the list of required immunizations children are required to have before attending a child care facility and requires child care facilities to provide information, which will be supplied by the Department of Human Services, to parents regarding meningococcal and pneumococcal disease and the availability of vaccine to protect the child against infection.
