Fiscal Analysis

According to the Oklahoma Department of Human Services (OKDHS), there is no anticipated fiscal impact to the agency, since child care facilities or individuals pay the cost of the national criminal history search. There may be a cost to OKDHS for technicians to capture the fingerprints on live scan machines; although, it may be accomplished with existing personnel. Once a streamlined process is in place and the initial education to the child care industry is complete, the workload is anticipated to remain the same.
