## *Bill Summary and Fiscal Impact*

**Bill Summary and Comments:** A local board of education may request to the State Board of Education a national criminal history record check for direct contact unsupervised volunteers or any school volunteers. The OSBI will obtain fingerprints of the various volunteers and require that the school district pay a search fee not to exceed Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) or the cost of the search, whichever is the lesser amount. After a volunteer passes a check, the volunteer will not be required to submit to additional checks unless required by a policy adopted by the board of education. Since this bill is permissive language, actual costs are unknown, however, there should be no cost to state funds. SDE reported that they may need to hire an administrative assistant. OSBI currently charges \$41 for a national criminal history record check with fingerprints.
