12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 10001 of Title 74, unless there
15 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 Any agency, board, commission, higher education institution,
17 career technology or common education institution may contract with
18 a third-party vendor to perform any and all employment screenings,
19 background checks and credit checks.

20 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2012.
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
