12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1-104, is  
14 amended to read as follows:

15 Section 1-104. A. A bicycle is a device upon which any person  
16 or persons may ride, propelled solely by human power through a belt,  
17 chain, or gears, and having two or more wheels, excluding mopeds.

18 B. An electric-assisted bicycle is any bicycle with:

19 1. Two or three wheels; and

20 2. Fully operative pedals for human propulsion and equipped  
21 with an electric motor:

22 a. with a power output not to exceed one thousand (1,000)  
23 watts,

- 1           b.   incapable of propelling the device at a speed of more  
2           than thirty (30) miles per hour on level ground, and  
3           c.   incapable of further increasing the speed of the  
4           device when human power alone is used to propel the  
5           device at a speed of thirty (30) miles per hour or  
6           more.

7 An electric-assisted bicycle shall meet the requirements of the  
8 Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standards as set forth in federal  
9 regulations and shall operate in such a manner that the electric  
10 motor disengages or ceases to function when the brakes are applied.

11       C.   A motorized bicycle is any bicycle having:

12       1.   Fully operative pedals for propulsion by human power;

13       2.   ~~An automatic transmission~~ A power drive system that  
14       functions directly or automatically without clutching or  
15       shifting by the operator after the drive system is engaged; and

16       3.   A combustion engine with a piston or rotor displacement of  
17 ~~one hundred fifty (150 cu cm)~~ eighty (80 cu cm) cubic centimeters or  
18 less, regardless of the number of chambers in the engine, which is  
19 capable of propelling the bicycle at a maximum design speed of not  
20 more than ~~thirty (30)~~ thirty-five (35) miles per hour on level  
21 ground.

22       D.   As used in this title, the term "bicycle" shall include  
23 tricycles, quadcycles, or similar human-powered devices, electric-

1 assisted bicycles, and motorized bicycles unless otherwise  
2 specifically indicated.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2012.
