An Act relating to memorial bridge designations;
designating the Bass Reeves Memorial Bridge;
requiring certain markers; providing for
codification; and declaring an emergency.

SUBJECT: Bridge designation

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.93 of Title 69, unless
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The bridge over the Arkansas River on United States Highway 62
within the limits of the City of Muskogee shall be designated as the
"Bass Reeves Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation
shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be
placed on the bridge.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
