An Act relating to memorial highway designations;
designating memorial highway and bridges; providing
for codification; and declaring an emergency.

SUBJECT: Memorial highway and bridge designations

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.93 of Title 69, unless
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The interchange of Interstate Highway 44 crossing Harvard Avenue
in Tulsa County shall be designated as the "Jerry Lasker Memorial
Interchange". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
permanent markers to be placed upon the highway bearing that name.

SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.94 of Title 69, unless
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The bridge over Salt Creek on State Highway 51 in Mannford shall
be designated as the "Vietnam War Veterans Memorial Bridge". The
Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
to be placed upon the bridge bearing that name.

SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.95 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The bridge located on N.E. 16th Street crossing over Interstate 35 in Oklahoma City shall be designated as the "Lecia Swain-Ross Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed on the bridge bearing that name.

SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.96 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The bridge located on N.E. 4th Street crossing over Interstate 35 in Oklahoma City shall be designated as the "C.E. Pittman Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed on the bridge bearing that name.

SECTION 5. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
