WHEREAS, the 2010-2011 Frederick A. Douglass High School Boys  
Basketball team of Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, won the Class 4A State  
Basketball Championship for the second consecutive year with a 64-52  
win over the Bridge Creek Bobcats, proving to themselves and to  
their fans that they are the best boys basketball team in the state  
of Oklahoma; and

WHEREAS, the Trojans, under head coach Terry Long, competed in  
the semifinals of the Beach Ball Classic in Myrtle Beach, South  
Carolina, and in the championship game of the Bass Pro Tournament of

Champions, which was televised nationally on CBS. Additionally, for the past two years the Trojans have well represented Oklahoma in the Nike Thanksgiving Hoop Feast in Dallas, Texas; and

Proving to be the top team in Oklahoma, the Trojans have not lost to any school in the state for the past two years; and

WHEREAS, the Frederick A. Douglass High School Boys Basketball team has been nationally ranked every week of the 2010-2011 season. The Trojans are currently ranked 26th in the nation; their highest ranking of the season was 7th nationally; and

WHEREAS, the Trojans' record season is a source of great honor and pride for Frederick A. Douglass High School, the Eastside Community, Oklahoma City, and the state of Oklahoma, where the mighty Trojans reign supreme.
